








Floor

5-Layer Laminated Construction

1. Galvanized steel underbelly

CoolStream Ducting

The Pursuit comes equipped with either a single 15,000 BTU AC or dual 15,000 BTU ACs depending on the floor plan. Each Air Conditioner is equipped with a heat pump.

The Pursuit has CoolStream® residential ducting. This is an air conditioning system that is ducted through the crowned, vacuum-bonded roof. The system is insulated ductwork with an antibacterial coating that resist mold and mildew build-up. Radius corners provide maximum efficiency

Other Motorhome manufacturers utilize molded block Styrofoam duct-work for their airflow. Styrofoam is comprised of thousands of miniscule circular beads that have microscopic pores. Over time, those pores will accumulate dust particles. Air conditioning is nothing more than displacing moisture from the inside of the coach and transferring it to the outside which means moisture flowing freely through the coach and interacting with dirt and dust. Over time, this can have an adverse affect, especially for customers that are very sensitive to allergies.





HOW DOES A HEAT PUMP OPERATE?

- These are two diagrams side by side of how the two systems function:
 - Air Conditioner as a **cooling** unit on the left
 - Air Conditioner as a <u>heating</u> unit on the right
- Notice the compressor drawing in both the cooling and heating modes



The reversing valve Rotates 90°. This changes the direction of the flow of the refrigerant. It goes in the opposite direction and this is the reverse of the cooling cycle. Instead of absorbing heat from inside the motorhome it absorbs heat from the air outside the motorhome and transfers that heat to the interior. Now the indoor coil has become Condenser and the outdoor coil has become Evaporator

Notice that the heat isn't generated by a gas furnace. It is just moved (or pumped) from the outside air to inside the motorhome. This is why the Heat Pump is so popular in moderate climates. It also functions effectively in colder climates when the outside temperature is 38° to 40° or warmer. You don't need to operate the furnace when the weather cools off. Because of the reversing valve you can use the same electric system as both an air conditioner and a heater!



Ford Chassis / Powertrain

The Pursuit is built on a Ford Chassis

- Ford 7.3L **2-Valve Triton** V8 gas engine
 - 350 Horsepower & 468 lbs.-ft. of torque
- Front and Rear 4-Wheel anti-lock disc brakes
- **6-Speed Automatic** Double Overdrive Transmission
 - 3-5% better gas mileage than 5-speed transmission
 - Lower RPMs = quieter in cockpit

Upgrades from the V10 to V8 Ford Chassis

 - Road jolts and shocks are reduced even further by the addition of front and rear variable-rate jounce bumpers
 - The Sach Twin Tube shock absorbers are found on Rolls Royce, Mercedes Benz, and Maserati.
- Robust Steering and 50 degree wheel cut (19.5" Tires)
- Coachmen orders chassis from Ford with **longer wheelbases** than the competition
 - Longer wheelbase causes more weight to exist between axles and less overhang resulting in smoother ride
 - Great Carrying capacity







Determining the Towing Capacity

Every Pursuit motorhome has a tow hitch rated at either 5,000 lb. or 8,000 lb. That **DOES NOT** mean it can tow 5,000 lbs. or 8,000 lbs. The tow capacity of a **fully loaded** motorhome is determined by subtracting the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) from the Gross Combined Weight Rating (GCWR).

Example: 18,000 lb. GVWR and 23,000 lb. GCWR has a capacity of 5,000 lbs.

So, how much weight beyond this rating can a motorhome tow?

Load the motorhome as it will be used and have it weighed. The difference between the actual weight and the GVWR will determine how much more the motorhome may safely tow.

Regardless of the hitch rating, always calculate the safe tow capacity of the motorhome, <u>NEVER exceeding the Hitch Rating, the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)</u> or the Gross Combined Weight Rating (GCWR).

Inverter Technology

Our generators are unlike anything that has ever been released on the market. The biggest single differentiator is the use of Inverter Technology on our unit. Our proprietary inverter uses a 5% pure sine wave that allows for cleaner, more efficient, stable power. This is the first time inverter technology will be available for RV onboard power generation. A generator with an inverter still produces AC electricity, just like a conventional generator. However, a rectifier is used to convert the AC electricity to DC power, and the DC power is "cleaned" and "smoothed" out by capacitors. In the final step giving this technology its name, the DC power is then converted back into clean AC power, resulting in consistent, reliable, "clean" power!

Why Purchase Inverter Technology

Inverter technology is widely recognized for offering cleaner, more stable power. In the electronic age, this couldn't be more important as many new electronic devices are using microprocessors, which are sensitive to the type of power used. When using unclean power, you run the risk of damaging the device or facing user errors/malfunctions. Your laptop, phones, gaming consoles, blue-ray players, and now kitchen devices will benefit substantially from the use of inverter technology. The result is more efficient power use and cleaner power!





NPS GENERATOR

The Pursuit has a NPS 4500 or 5500 generator, depending on the floorplan, that is powered by Yamaha. It has a 3-year / 2000-hour warranty, integrated pull start, remote start with key fob and the largest network of service locations in the industry.



100 Watt Solar panel is standard on every Pursuit Roof

- Provides 8-10 amps of power per hour
- Will help trickle charge your house batteries
- **Bulk Charge**, battery voltage has not yet reached boost voltage and 100% of available solar power is used to charge the battery
- Boost Charge, when the battery has recharged to the boost voltage set point, constant – current regulation is used to prevent heating and excessive battery gassing.






